The NCAA® Men's Final Four® is coming to Indianapolis in April 2021, and we are thrilled to welcome you and your child to the Read to the Final Four® Reading Challenge. Thousands of Indiana third graders are eligible to compete as a school-wide reading team and advance through rounds of competition that mirror the NCAA® tournament.

Your child's school has registered for this challenge, which will give them unlimited access to 6,000 age-appropriate digital books on Renaissance myON®. This digital library can be accessed by students at school, home, or anywhere across the community with Wi-Fi on a web-based device. No matter where your child is reading, minutes will be tracked, so please encourage them to read outside of the classroom - at home and on weekends. Students will have access to the platform through June 30, 2021, so they can continue reading once the bracket-style competition ends.

Follow the steps below to get started reading on myON Reader.



1. Log In

Go to www.myON.com and click on the  button

2. Select Books

From their dashboards, students can select **recommended** books that match their interests and reading level. They can also browse and search the entire collection, and tag books to add to their own lists for future reading.



3. Start Reading!

The book reader allows students to select optional reading supports including audio, text highlighting and an embedded dictionary for any book they choose to read.
